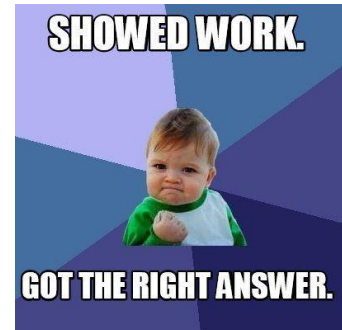

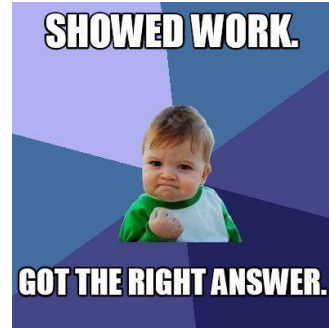
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This year in Algebra your child will be learning:

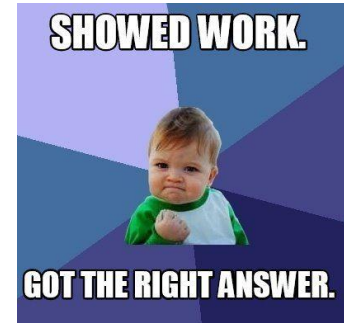
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This year in Intermediate Algebra, your child will be learning about:
